

MATURE WOMAN SCHOLARSHIPS

The Woman's Club of Raleigh recognizes the need for continuing education; therefore, it offers several scholarships valued up to \$1500, for women 30 years of age or older who desire entry, re-entry, or are currently enrolled in a North Carolina college at the undergraduate level. An applicant must be a resident of Wake County. Factors to be considered are financial need, dedication to service in the community, and predicted success in a chosen field.

The applicant must submit the following:

1. A completed application form
2. A written proposal for a course-of-study with a statement of goals (one page).
3. Two letters of recommendation (in sealed envelopes). Applicant may seek letters from:
 - An Educator
 - A Business/professional employer
 - A Co-workerNote: A letter from a friend is not acceptable.
4. Items 1, 2, and 3 above should be mailed together in a 9 x 12 envelope.
5. The applicant should be available for an interview with the scholarship committee at the Woman's Club Clubhouse during the month of March.
