

THE SALLIE SOUTHALL COTTEN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

This scholarship is awarded based on the candidate's character, scholastic records, evidence of intellectual promise, demonstration of ambition, leadership ability, and need for financial assistance. Applicant must be present for judging and presentation of the scholarship at the time and place designated.

1. Applicant must be a resident of North Carolina and must be a member of a senior class in an accredited North Carolina School.
2. Applicant must be in the upper fourth of the class.
3. Applicant must use the official application form.
4. The scholarship is to be used at a four-year college or university in the state of North Carolina.

THE FOLLOWING MUST BE SUBMITTED 1.

Application form found on this website.

2. Recent photograph.
3. A personal letter as to why student desires to continue his/her education, the student's future plans, and why financial aid is necessary.
4. Letter of recommendation from either the school principal, school guidance counselor, or a school teacher.
5. Letter of recommendation from a business or professional person **OTHER THAN SCHOOL PERSONNEL**.
6. High school transcript with grades through the first semester of senior year, complete SAT and/or ACT scores, class rank with number of students in class, and grade point average weighted and unweighted.
7. Copy of most recent Federal Tax Returns or FAFSA Summary for applicant's parent(s) and applicant. Document any significant changes in family income if necessary. Student should mark out SSN before submission.
8. Applicant should be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee at The Woman's Club of Raleigh.

1. Deadline: January 15, 2023

No applicant will be considered unless all required items listed above have been received by the deadline.
