Through our Community Service Programs (CSPs), The Woman's Club of Raleigh cultivates meaningful relationships and collaborations with other local non-profits, assesses community needs, and coordinates activities that create lasting change. Our Community Partners like you strengthen and expand this impact throughout our local community.

Our members – primarily businesswomen, educators, and healthcare professionals – are committed to expanding opportunity. Because of this strong professional foundation, we recognize the importance of expanding access to higher education. We proudly offer scholarships to both graduating high school seniors and adult learners seeking to continue or complete their education. In addition, we provide grants to fellow community nonprofits, supporting and strengthening their missions.

What sets our partnership with the community apart is that we do more than provide funding. We engage personally – with our hands, our hearts, and our talents – working alongside those we serve. Since 1904, the Woman's Club of Raleigh has served the Greater Raleigh community. We believe the dedication, commitment, and volunteer spirit of our members contributes meaningfully to the growth and improvement of our community. Our members volunteered 15,685 hours back into the community this past year.

A small sample of our current Club Activities and Events:

## Scholarships, Art Awards and Grants awarded in 2025

- Awarded two middle school students with Citizenship Awards, total \$200.
- Awarded three high school senior scholarships, total \$11,000
- Awarded one mature woman scholarship, total \$5,000 for returning to college.
- Awarded one continuing college student scholarship, total \$2,500.
- Awarded five grants to help fund local non-profit organizations, total \$12,800.
- Awarded six student artists at the Arts and Music Festival with monetary awards, total \$650.
- Awarded President's Project recipient Mount Vernon Middle School, total \$2,000.

\*Additional funding will allow us to increase the number of awards and/or amount of money provided to the recipients of the grants, awards, and scholarships.

## Community Engagement

- Provided Foreign Policy Association's *Great Decisions* Series - open to the public
- Event and Voter registration drives; UNC Rex Food Bank, You can Vote NC,
- Collaborates and supports local organization through volunteering and participating in organizational drives, i.e., clothing, diapers, educational supplies, food, hygiene products.
- Features monthly guest speakers from local organizations and recognizes community services/individuals for their work and contributions to the safety and well-being of the community. Honorariums provided.

Additional funding would allow us to award all guest speakers and honored guests at our monthly meetings a more substantial honorarium. Our current typical honorarium is \$100+.
